General Practice standards and requirements

- I understand and agree to comply with all requirements of the RACGP Standards for General Practice Training (3rd edition) as they apply to supervisors.
- I agree to comply with the RACGP Codes and principles for training sites and supervisors as applicable.
- I understand and agree to comply with the RACGP remote supervisor key expectations and requirements.
- I understand and agree that to complete professional development as per RACGP requirements.
- I agree to inform RACGP of any changes in circumstances including changes to my supervision availability.
- I agree to contribute to a safe environment for the registrar and to promptly notify the RACGP of any event which is likely to adversely affect the standing of the practice, its staff, the training program or the RACGP in any way.
- I acknowledge and accept that continued accreditation is subject to monitoring and review. This includes demonstrated capacity of the supervisor to deliver effective training to registrars in accordance with the stage of training and expectations set out in the standards and codes referred to above.

Registrar placements

- I acknowledge and accept that the RACGP cannot guarantee a continuity of supply of registrars allocated to me for remote supervision.
- I acknowledge and accept that the RACGP may restrict the number of registrars I am able to supervise concurrently.
- I agree to accept registrar allocations for remote supervision as appropriate throughout the accreditation period.

Issues and disputes

- I understand and agree to the following:
- If the supervisor does not provide the agreed level of supervision, the RACGP will seek to support the supervisor to remediate the situation.
 - Disputes resolution is initially undertaken through discussion with the relevant RACGP Medical Educators and the supervisor.
 - Performance and compliance issues may be escalated to the Regional Accreditation Panel.
 - On rare occasions where supervisor remediation has not been successful and concerns remain, accreditation will be withdrawn. The RACGP will advise de-accreditation in writing.
 - Training sites are able to request reconsideration of accreditation or appeal decisions.
