## Censor-in-Chief elections

In accordance with clause 65(c) of the constitution of The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners Ltd (RACGP), nominations signed by not less than two members eligible to make nominations and countersigned by the nominee are hereby called for:

### **CENSOR-in-CHIEF**

To hold office from the conclusion of the RACGP's Annual General Meeting to be held on 21 November 2024 until the conclusion of the RACGP's 2026 Annual General Meeting.

Nominees must be Fellows of the RACGP.

## Nominations

Nominations must be written and comply with the [RACGP Constitution](#) and [RACGP Elections Policy](#). Nominations must be addressed to the Returning Officer, Mr Gavin Ryan at [elections@racgp.org.au](mailto:elections@racgp.org.au) and can be lodged from 12.00pm (AEST), Monday 6 May 2024 until 4.00pm (AEST), Monday 3 June 2024. Nominations cannot be accepted or withdrawn after this time.

**Nomination form:** Nomination forms are available on the RACGP Elections website.

## Candidate statements

To support a nomination candidates may, along with their nomination form, provide a statement in support of their election in accordance with the following:

- for distribution with the Ballot materials and on the RACGP website, a statement not exceeding 2000 words and a colour photograph of themselves in high resolution, jpeg format.
- for placement on the RACGP website, a curriculum vitae\* of no more than 2000 words and a short candidate video (maximum duration five minutes) and its transcript.

*All materials submitted must comply with the [RACGP Elections Policy](#).*

**\*NB: It's important that CVs do not contain the nominees personal home address for privacy protection.**
