2. Describe the features of non-melanoma and melanoma skin cancers
3. Develop a comprehensive primary care surveillance and management plan for patients diagnosed with skin cancer
4. Recognise the most appropriate biopsy/suturing technique based on lesion type and location.
5. Identify when referral is warranted.
6. Apply surgical techniques in the biopsy, removal and suturing of skin lesions.
