# A new look for *gplearning* in 2024 for learners associated with GP training

We are excited to launch new functionality in *gplearning* on 22 January 2024 with curated content for AGPT registrars, supervisors, external clinical teaching visitors and medical educators as well as easier links to the RACGP curriculum and syllabus e-learning content. These changes are additions to the interface and are visible only if you are linked to the AGPT training program.

You will still have all the functions of other RACGP members, but we have added a few extras to enhance and simplify your learning experience.

The changes have been guided by 3 philosophies:

- 1. The RACGP curriculum and syllabus should be the guiding force behind the structure of learning and development for GP registrars.
- 2. The learning journey for GPs is a continuum, and we require different resources and materials depending on the stage of that journey.
- 3. Stuff should be easy to find!

#### The learner journeys



After you log into *gplearning* – you will notice six learner journey tiles at the top of the LMS dashboard. For a collection of useful resources, select a tile that applies to your current stage of the learning journey in general practice.

Each of the tiles will take you to a course enrolment page where you can self-enrol and check out the content. The learner journey courses contain curated content guided by a number of teams within GP training. We hope that these



courses become a collaborative space. They are a work in progress and will evolve with the help of your suggestions and feedback.

If you enrol in any of the learner journey courses, it will appear in the 'Training Related' or 'All' tab of the 'Courses I'm enrolled in' section. Below is a screenshot of what the 'Training Related' tab would look like if you were enrolled in all the learner journey courses.



### **Content Quick Search**

The 'Content Quick Search' widget (visible on the right of the above screenshot) remains the same as a feature where you can quickly see resources and topics of interest that are linked to specific training program materials; or you can search content by CPD type.

#### The curriculum and syllabus for GP training

As you advance down the home page you will find a familiar interface. We have added core and contextual unit buttons that resemble the RACGP curriculum and syllabus website. Please refer to screenshot on the next page.

When you click on any of these buttons, you will be taken to a pre-set search list of gplearning courses that are:

- specifically recommended in the RACGP curriculum and syllabus
- developed by GP training (and the former regional training organisations) for GP registrars and mapped to the curriculum and syllabus.

Please note that by default the core and contextual unit buttons will show only courses that you are Not Yet Enrolled in. However, you can change the drop-down menu on the Discover page to see the Already Enrolled courses.
