General

Question	Answer
Will we get links to book in for the CAAKT and MMIs on 9 May?	Our teams are hard at work processing the 2025 AGPT applications. You'll receive an email about the next steps including details on how to pay and book in for your assessments by Thursday 9 May.
How are the CAAKT and MMIs weighted?	The CAAKT and MMI contribute equally your assessment score.
Do we receive results/feedback for the MMI and CAAKT?	No. You will not be able to access your CAAKT and MMI results.
Will GP practices have access to our rankings?	No. The selection process assesses your suitability to enter a GP training program. This information is not available to GP practices who you may apply to train with when you enter the community GP stage of training.
What if I don't get an offer, or I decline an offer in this AGPT intake, can I participate in later intakes?	<p>If you are deemed suitable for an offer, but don't get an offer or decline an offer, you may be able to participate in a second intake for 2025 <u>if one is held</u>. We will update our website to advise whether there will be a second intake in late May.</p> <p>If you are deemed unsuitable for a training offer in this intake, you are unable to participate in second intake for the same training year.</p> <p>All doctors are however welcome to reapply in subsequent years.</p>

Candidate Assessment and Applied Knowledge Test (CAAKT)

Question	Answer
How can I prepare?	Visit our website for some useful resources and information to help you prepare for the CAAKT.
Can I sit the CAAKT in a location other than the region I'm applying for or live in?	Yes. You are welcome to book to sit the CAAKT in any of the available locations.
What happens if the date you want to sit the CAAKT is booked out?	You will need to book another date. If you have any problems, please contact us on becomeagp@racgp.org.au
Are there multiple sittings of the CAAKT per day?	Yes, these will become visible once you have paid and you have received the booking links.
When can we see where the exact test centre locations are? At this stage, I believe we can only see the city names.	This information comes in your selection booking confirmation email.
Is there an option to sit the CAAKT remotely for applicants who are currently working in regional and rural areas?	Remote sittings are not available. Candidates are required to sit the CAAKT at one of the locations provided. If you have any problems, please contact us on becomeagp@racgp.org.au
How long is the CAAKT assessment?	2.5 hours
How many questions are in the CAAKT?	The test is made up of 80 questions; 20 Situational Judgement Test questions and 60 Knowledge Test questions.
Are all questions weighted equally in the CAAKT exam?	Yes. All questions are worth the same value.
Will we be given rough working paper in the CAAKT?	Yes, you will receive working paper at the venue, which will be destroyed on the completion of your CAAKT.
Can I bring a pencil into the exam?	No. You cannot bring anything into the exam room.
Can I bring a sugary snack into the exam?	No, unless you have completed a special arrangements request form and this has been approved in advance of attending the CAAKT.

Do we bring our own computers for the CAAKT or is it provided by the centre?	No, you will complete the test on a computer at the CAAKT venue.
Can I bring water into the CAAKT test centre?	No. You cannot bring anything into the exam room. Water is available within the room for you to access.
Once you have completed a question, can you go back to review it?	Yes, you can flag it and return to it if you have time.
What should we do if we are sick on test day?	Contact us urgently on the hotline number provided in your confirmation email. (03 8699 0988)
At the completion of our exam/allocated CAAKT timeslot, will we be required to stay, or able to leave the exam site straight away?	You can leave as soon as you are finished. There is no need to wait for the entire room to finish.

Multiple Mini Interviews (MMIs)

Question	Answer
How can I prepare?	Visit our website for some useful resources and information to help you prepare for the MMIs.
Is the AGPT application number when booking MMI the same as the applicant ID or RACGP ID?	Yes, it is the applicant ID.
Do we need to show our ID on Zoom?	Yes. You will need to have your driver's licence or passport or suitable photo ID.
How long do the MMIs take?	The MMI process takes two hours.
Are the interviewers for MMIs all GPs?	The majority of interviewers will be GPs.
How many interviewers are there at each station in the MMI?	There are five stations, and there will be one interviewer at each station.

How long do we have to answer each question?	You will have two minutes reading time and eight minutes answer time for each question.
Are all questions with the same interviewers or do we move between stations?	We will move you between five different stations with five different interviewers.
Will we be able to write prompts for ourselves during the MMI? Do we need to hand in our notes at the end? If so, how?	You can take notes during the MMI. We ask that you dispose of these notes after the interview.
Will the questions remain on screen during answer time?	Yes, questions will remain on the screen for both the reading and answer time.
Will the stations be in a random order? For example, is the first station for the first domain of general practice etc.	Yes, the stations will be in random order.
Do we have to install any specific software on our computer for the MMI?	You'll need to have Zoom loaded and have tested it prior to the MMI to ensure it's working correctly.
What should we do if we are sick or have issues on test day?	Contact us urgently on the hotline number provided in your confirmation email. (03 8699 0988)

Training preferences

Question	Answer
Can we change our preferences after submitting the application?	You can change your training preferences between 8 – 17 May.
Can you change your preferences after 5pm AEST 17 May?	No.
Does preferencing more options make you more likely to get an undersubscribed area?	<p>No. The determination of offers will depend on many factors including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · meeting eligibility criteria · your performance in the CAAKT and MMIs · your training region and pathway preferences · being able to meet the requirements of training. <p>Preferencing more options may increase your chances of being made an offer.</p>
