ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Quality of Research Proposal

- Background & justification of research (understanding of pertinent literature)
- Research question(s)
- Appropriateness of design & methods (data collection, analysis and dissemination)
- Scope and feasibility of research
- Overall quality of proposal (clarity of writing, adherence to instructions)

Potential of proposed project to meet ERG objectives

- Potential to build research capacity and skills in the GP Training sector
 - Potential to promote a culture of academic critique and the use of evidence in GP training
 - Potential to facilitate collaboration between researchers, universities and the training sector
 - Potential for dissemination and implementation of findings
 - Potential to improve GP training
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
