An official letter from your training organisation confirming:

- this is their curriculum;
- the year of the curriculum;
- the specialist general practice qualification it leads to; and
- the year you obtained this qualification.

If any of these documents are not in English, you must provide a copy of the original and an official English translation. To support your curriculum comparison application, please also provide an official document from the college, training organisation or Medical Board that outlines their good medical practice guidelines and ethics.
