


# Supporting registrars on their journey to Fellowship



## Priya

Priya is an international medical graduate (IMG) who is new to Australia. She has four years' experience in hospital and community-based settings in India. Priya has passed the AMC Part 1 exam and holds limited registration (Ahpra Level 3 supervision).

**Applicant assessment:** Limited registration; two years' FTE clinical experience overseas; no Australian clinical experience; suitable on the national entry assessment (NEA).

**Outcome:** Priya is offered standard entry to the Foundation Term (six months FTE) based on limited registration and insufficient Australian clinical experience. Priya's performance is reviewed at the end of the Foundation term, and she is deemed suitable to progress to FSP Term 1.

Priya received a performance flag in Term 1 following a mini clinical evaluation exercise observed by a medical educator (ME) for a prescribing error. She had follow-up feedback with her ME mentor and successfully completed a focused learning intervention under the oversight of the Progression Review Committee. She progressed through the remainder of her training without further concerns.

Priya commences exams in FSP Term 3, passes and achieves Fellowship in 2.5 years.

## Tran

Tran is an Australian medical graduate and holds general registration. He has five years' generalist experience in Australian hospitals, including a 12-week paediatric rotation in Postgraduate Year 3 (PGY3). Tran has no general practice experience.

**Applicant assessment:** General registration; two years' FTE clinical experience; adequate generalist Australian clinical experience; meets the paediatric competency requirement; suitable on the NEA.

**Outcome:** Tran is offered advanced entry to FSP Term 1 based on registration status, breadth of experience in the Australian healthcare system and paediatric competency.

Tran progresses through FSP terms 1–4. He commences exams in FSP Term 4 and fails the Clinical Competency Exam (CCE). Tran completes a six-month extension term and achieves Fellowship in 2.5 years.

## Amir

Amir is an IMG with four years' clinical experience in Iran. He relocated to Australia three years ago and holds general registration. Amir has passed the AMC Part 1 and 2 exams. He has one year's general practice experience in a rural setting and completed the paediatric requirement during his general practice placement.

**Applicant assessment:** General registration; two years' FTE clinical experience; one year's generalist Australian experience; meets the paediatric competency requirement; suitable on the NEA.

**Outcome:** Amir is offered advanced entry to FSP Term 1 based on registration status and breadth of mixed general practice experience in Australia, including paediatrics.

Amir progresses through FSP terms 1–4. He commences exams in FSP Term 3 and achieves Fellowship in two years.
