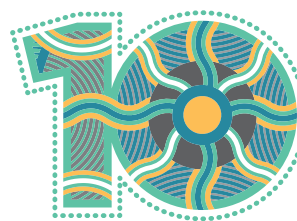

The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Medical Student award is open to Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander medical students currently studying at an Australian university.

Eligible nominees

Nominees for the Medical Student award must:

- be a current Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander medical student at an Australian university
- have an interest in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health and a career in general practice.

Nominees must also provide a written statement outlining how the award would support their professional development.

Nomination process

To nominate yourself or someone else, complete the nomination form and email it to aboriginalhealth@racgp.org.au by **Friday 4 September 2020**.

What's the selection process?

A panel made up of the faculty's Awards Committee will select the award winner.

What are the key dates?

Nominations open on **Monday 6 July 2020** and close on **Friday 4 September 2020**.

What are the award conditions?

The Medical Student award will only be granted to a nominee who satisfies the eligibility criteria. The winner must consent to be interviewed by *newsGP* journalists and pictured in college and faculty communications, such as articles and social media posts.

The faculty was established to:

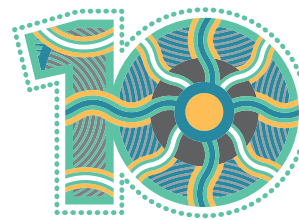
- drive the RACGP's commitment to developing a culturally informed GP workforce
