## RACGP Rural Procedural Grants Program Australian Privacy Principle 5 Notification

The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (RACGP) of Level 2, 100 Wellington Parade, East Melbourne, Victoria, collects personal information about you to assess your eligibility to participate in the Rural Procedural Grants Program (RPGP).

If you do not disclose your personal information to the RACGP, then we may not be able to assess your eligibility for RPGP.

Your personal information will be disclosed to the Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM) to verify if you are also enrolled with ACRRM. Information may also be disclosed by the RACGP to the Department of Health (DOH) for statistical, evaluation, research and/or policy development purposes. This data will be largely de-identified data.
