## Funding influenza vaccines for all Victorians

### Vaccination grants and reimbursement program for primary care

Influenza vaccines are being supplied at no cost to all Victorians from 1 June to 10 July 2022 by pharmacies and GPs registered to the program

Reimbursement for influenza vaccines delivered between 1 June – 30 June 2022 and 1 – 10 July 2022 (optional extension)



Additional one-off grant paid at end of program to immunisation providers that meet select criteria in support of immunisation service delivery (e.g. additional staffing, after hour services)

# Funding influenza vaccines for all Victorians – registration and reporting

Registered GP clinics 1,414

Registered pharmacies 764

Total registrations 2,178

#### As of Tuesday 12 July...

- 693 out of 1,414 GP clinics have reported their data for June (49%)
- 156 have reported July data (11%)
- Average eligible doses per clinic: 170
- Highest reported vaccine numbers per clinic: >1,500

Providers have until 25th July to report their vaccination numbers and claim the grant.




## Funding influenza vaccines for all Victorians - evaluation

88% of vaccination providers reported an increase in demand for influenza vaccine.

**50%** reported a **significant increase in demand** (>50% increase).

Most noticeable increase was in non-NIP patients aged 16-64 years.




