

2026.2 GPT3 Registrar Out-of-Practice Education Program

Training region: North Eastern New South Wales

Training sub-region: New England Northwest

Registrars must attend the RACGP's out-of-practice education program during their GPT3 term as a requirement to Fellow. Attendance contributes to their education hours within the registrar's TMS portfolio.

The out-of-practice education program comprises a mix of large group and small group activities facilitated either face to face or via an online platform. The peer-led small group learning (SGL) sessions are specifically focused on registrars working in a stable group with their peers and medical educators. The small group learning sessions are semi-structured and tailored to the learning needs of the group. The out-of-practice education program is underpinned by the [RACGP Curriculum and syllabus](#).

Registrars are required to attend 24 hours in their GPT3 term. Hours are counted differently when face-to-face or when online, please refer to the education hours column for hours accrued and not the time column.
