Registrars must attend the RACGP's Out-of-Practice Education Program during their GPT1 and GPT2 terms as a requirement to Fellow. Attendance contributes to their education hours within the registrar's Training Management System (TMS) portfolio.

The Out-of-Practice Education Program comprises a mix of large group and small group activities facilitated either face-to-face or via an online platform. The peer-led small group learning (SGL) sessions are specifically focused on registrars working in a stable group with their peers and medical educators. The SGL sessions are semi-structured and tailored to the learning needs of the group.
