Supervisor educational events are delivered at a regional and local level both face-to-face and online to ensure all supervisors have access to professional development. These events present an excellent opportunity to connect with your fellow supervisors and medical educators in a friendly and collegiate environment. Increasingly we will be using peer-led small group learning sessions as the basis for supervisor education as this will enable you to learn from your peers and have education that meets your needs.

All the local and regional supervisor education events for existing supervisors listed in this calendar will automatically qualify as contributing to the supervisor professional development stipend paid to the eligible training sites.
