

# 2026.1 GPT1 and GPT2 Registrar Out-of-Practice Education Program

Registrars must attend the RACGP's out of practice education program during their GPT1 & GPT2 terms as a requirement to Fellow. The program consists of peer led small group learning and larger group sessions. Attendance contributes to their education hours within the registrar's TMS portfolio.

The out-of-practice education program is comprised of a mix of large group and small group activities either facilitated face to face or via an online platform. The peer-led small group (SGLs) sessions are specifically focused on registrars working in a stable group with their peers and medical educators. The small group learning sessions are semi-structured and tailored to the learning needs of the group.
