

2018 Student bursary for the RACGP's annual conference GP18



The RACGP National Faculty of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health invites Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander medical students currently studying at an Australian university to apply for a student bursary to attend the RACGP's annual conference, GP18, on the Gold Coast from 11 –13 October 2018.

A bursary will be offered, covering conference registration, travel, meals and accommodation costs for the conference period.

GP18 is a highlight of the general practice events calendar, attended by GPs, medical educators, students, registrars, key influencers in Australian general practice and members of practice teams. Past conferences have been a huge success attracting up to 1000 delegates from across the country and internationally.

'General Practice: The centre of health in Australia' will bring together GPs from around Australia to the Gold Coast for four days of education, skills building and networking.

The successful recipient of the RACGP bursary will be selected on the basis of their:

- eligibility as a current Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait
 Islander medical student at an Australian university
- demonstrated interest in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health
- written statement outlining the ways in which the bursary would support their professional development.

Selection process

Selection of the successful bursary winner will be made by a panel comprised of the faculty's award committee.

The bursary will only be granted to an applicant who satisfies the above criteria. The successful applicant must agree to attend the GP18 conference proceedings and provide a report to the faculty shortly thereafter.
