Faculty Councils

In accordance with Appendix 3 of the <u>Elections Policy</u> of The Royal Australian College of General Practitioners, nominations signed by not less than two members eligible to make nominations and countersigned by the nominee are hereby called for,

FACULTY COUNCILLORS

To hold office from the conclusion of the Faculty's annual members meeting until the conclusion of the Faculty's 2025 annual members meeting.

Nominees must be Fellows, Members or Registrar Associates of the RACGP (excluding the National Faculty of GPs in Training). Nominees for Councillors of the National Faculty of GPs in Training must be Fellows of not more than five (5) years standing at the conclusion of the RACGP's 2025 Annual General Meeting or Registrar Associates.

Nominations

Nominations must be written and otherwise comply with the <u>RACGP Constitution</u>. Nominations must be addressed to the Returning Officer, Mr Gavin Ryan at <u>elections@racgp.org.au</u> from 12.00pm (AEST) Wednesday 26 July 2023 and must be received by 4.00pm (AEST) Friday 18 August 2023. Nominations cannot be accepted or withdrawn after this time.

Candidate statements

To support the nomination, candidates may, along with their nomination form, provide a statement in support of their election in accordance with the following:

- for distribution with ballot materials, a statement not exceeding 1000 words and a colour photo of themselves in high resolution jpeg format.
- for display on the RACGP website, a curriculum vitae* of no more than 2000 words

All submitted materials must comply with the RACGP Elections Policy.

*NB: It's important that CV's do not contain the nominees' personal home address for privacy protection.
