This document has been submitted by Dr Evan Ackermann, Chair of the RACGP Expert Committee– Quality Care, and is endorsed by the President and Chair of Council (Out-of-Session Endorsement).

Recommendation

That Council ratifies the endorsement of the RACGP response to the draft labelling order for medicines as endorsed by the President and Chair of Council (Out-of-Session).

Background & Justification

Improving the quality of medicines naming, labelling and packaging in Australia is an ongoing aim of the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA). In response to comments received during the consultation on medicine labelling conducted in late 2014, new draft Orders have been developed.

As part of a targeted consultation process, the TGA has invited the RACGP to provide feedback on proposed changes and *Guideline for medicine labels*.

In developing a response, the Quality Care team consulted with members of the RACGP Expert Committee – Quality Care. Our brief response focuses on the need for consistency, clarity and readability of information for health users of different literacy levels.

Strategic alignment
