2	GP Training Transition Contingencies <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitor issue and hold until next UGPA meeting. GPRA and GPSA to work on developing ongoing issues regarding training. Put "GP Training Transition Contingencies" on GP Stakeholder meeting agenda; request Department to reply before Christmas.

5	Discussions with Shadow Minister for Health, The Hon Catherine King MP <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Formally write to Catherine King regarding the need for a 3GA exemption, so States can fund a prevocational training program. Catherine King to raise issue with Health Minister once received formal request from GPRA
