The objective of the course is to better prepare potential PESCI candidates for the structured PESCI panel interview, as well as improve candidates understanding of what the PESCI assessment panel team look for in candidates resumes regarding past and recent medical education workshops/courses.

This course is also beneficial for IMGs preparing for the AMC clinical examinations.
