## Respiratory health

### Wednesday 8 August

- Identifying and managing patients who present with acute shortness of breath
- The wheezy child

- Appropriate use of antibiotics for respiratory infections
- Asthma – acute management, the action plan, what's new in treatment and managing asthma in the long term and exacerbations.

## Child and adolescent mental health
