Who can join the RACGP, and what's the fee?

All GPs with a valid international medical registration are eligible to apply for the RACGP Overseas – International membership. The membership year runs from 1 July 2021 – 30 June 2022.

We would like to offer you Overseas – International membership at an annual rate of AU\$287.57, which is a total saving of A\$297.65 if you purchase before 30 June 2021.

Payment can be made by credit card (which will incur no additional fees) or bank transfer (which may incur transfer and currency conversion fees).



How can you join?

- 1 Complete the attached membership application form.
- 2 Email your completed application to **membership@racgp.org.au** and we'll send you an invoice.
- 3 Pay your invoice and you'll get your RACGP ID number and access to the RACGP member website.
- 4 Pay the invoice attached to your email OR log in to **www.racgp.org.au** using your member ID to complete your payment.

How can you renew your membership?

- 1 You'll receive an email from the RACGP with a membership renewal invoice for 2020–21.
- 2 Pay the invoice attached to the email OR log in to your account on the RACGP website. Go to the 'Renew' link under 'Membership' and click 'Pay invoice online' in the payment section.
- 3 Wait for your renewal confirmation email.
