



## Exemption

### **Public Health (COVID-19 Self-Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021**

Made under the *Public Health Act 2010 (NSW)*

I, Richard Broome, delegate of the Minister for Health, being satisfied that it is necessary to protect the health and well-being of any member of the public, under clause 15 of the *Public Health (COVID-19 Self Isolation) Order (No 4) 2021 (the Order)*, hereby grant the following exemption from Order:

1. An Exempt Person is exempt from clauses 7A and 8 of the Order but only in relation to attending a general practice examination on Friday 4 February 2022 or Saturday 5 February 2022 with the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners (**the Examination**) and subject to the conditions at Clause 2.
2. The exemption at clause 1 is subject to the following conditions:
  - a) The Exempt Person must only leave their place of residence/isolation to attend the Examination if the Exempt Person does not have any symptoms of COVID-19 (including coughing, fever, sneezing, nasal congestion).
  - b) The Exempt Person must travel by the most practicable direct route to and from the Examination and their place of residence/isolation in private vehicle (not public transport).
  - c) The Exempt Person must have a negative COVID-19 rapid antigen test (RAT) on the morning of the Examination.
  - d) The Exempt Person must, on arrival to, and while at, the Examination:
    - wear an N95/P2 mask; and
    - take reasonably practicable steps to remain 1.5 metres from any other person at the Examination.

In this instrument:

- 1) An Exempt Person means a person undertaking the NSW Fellowship Exam for the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners

This exemption instrument may be revoked at any time.
