Nominations

Nominations must be written and otherwise comply with the RACGP Constitution. Nominations must be addressed to the Returning Officer, Mr Richard Kidd, c/- elections@racgp.org.au from Monday 29 June 12:00pm AEST until 12:00pm Thursday 30 July 2020. Nominations cannot be withdrawn after this time.

Candidate statements

To support a nomination candidates may, along with their nomination form, provide a statement in support of their election in accordance with the following:

- for distribution with Ballot materials, a statement not exceeding 1000 words and a colour photo of themselves in high resolution jpeg format (min 1MB)
- for placement on the RACGP website, a statement not exceeding 2000 words, a curriculum vitae of no more than 2000 words and a short video (maximum 5 minutes in duration) and its transcript.

All submitted materials must comply with the RACGP Elections Policy, available on the RACGP website.

The Ballot will open at 12:00pm AEST on Tuesday 4 August 12:00pm and will close at 12:00pm AEST Monday 18 August 2020.
