The EASL involves:

- Multiple-choice questionnaire
- EASL Pack: This is a document that is completed together with your supervisor that includes your orientation checklist, Call for Help, Clinical Supervision Plan and teaching plan.
- Clinical case analysis (CCA): two cases to be submitted by registrar and assessed by supervisor in the FSP Portal.
- Direct observation (mini-CEX): four patient consultations to be observed and assessed by supervisor. Supervisors are expected to commit one hour per day for the first two weeks (total 10 hours) to conduct these activities.
