Your Role

The Technical Project Manager – Grow Initiatives plays a key role in delivering technology enhancements and business-enabling initiatives within the RACGP's Digital Transformation Program. Focused on incremental improvements this role leads the delivery of multiple small to mid-sized projects across both front-office, back-office and digital platforms—such as CRM, ERP, HR systems, Website.

The role is responsible for coordinating internal and vendor delivery teams to execute projects that enhance capability, improve operational efficiency, and create additional value for members and employees. You will work closely with product owners, platform leads, and business stakeholders to ensure initiatives are well scoped, resourced, and delivered to expectation.

Operating within the RACGP's future-focused technology environment, the role helps embed modern delivery practices and agile principles while supporting continuous improvement of the College's digital and technology ecosystem.

Key Responsibilities

- Plan and manage the end-to-end delivery of small to mid-sized technology and digital initiatives aligned to RACGP's growth roadmap.
- Collaborate with stakeholders to define scope, objectives, and success metrics, ensuring alignment with business and member needs.
- Coordinate vendor partners and internal delivery teams, ensuring clear execution plans and on-time, fit-for-purpose outcomes.
- Maintain and track integrated project plans, ensuring alignment with enterprise technology and transformation roadmaps.
- Identify and manage project risks, dependencies, and issues, including timely escalation and resolution planning.
- Monitor and report on budget, progress, risks, and benefits realisation to relevant governance forums.
- Support transition to BAU by ensuring documentation, training, and operational readiness are planned and delivered alongside project outcomes.
- Champion agile and hybrid delivery methods, driving cadence, transparency, and adaptability across teams.
- Ensure workplace health & safety standards are in place and act as a safety role model to ensure the safety of all people through appropriate anticipation, identification and mitigation of risks

- Ensure through your leadership approach that an inclusive working environment & culture thrives within the RACGP that focuses on outcomes for our employees that improve engagement, retention, development and productivity
- Develop talent and ensure diverse talent pipelines to provide succession candidates for all key leadership positions
- Comply with all relevant workplace policies and procedures, acting as a safety role model
