newsGP sits within the Content & Creative team, which also produces and distributes titles such as the Australian Journal of General Practice (AJGP).

Your Role

The role is best suited to a GP or registrar who has obtained registration or is on a recognised pathway and who has a strong writing background. The GP Journalist will be responsible for producing daily newsGP articles often, though not exclusively, from a clinical angle, ultimately from the viewpoint of, 'how will this help a GP in their day-to-day practice?' They'll work closely with internal experts to deliver clear, concise copy. The ability to liaise and maintain positive relationships with a variety of internal stakeholders is vital.

The GP Journalist will work with the Editor of newsGP to gather information and report on issues relevant to the members of the RACGP. They'll be required to:

- · research and write news-focused articles, profiles and feature articles
- contribute to the editorial agenda by suggesting ideas for stories and innovative ways of covering these issues
- be aware of current issues in the medical and healthcare fields
- · provide insight into everyday challenges that GPs face to help inform content
- · ensure all copy is filed to agreed deadlines.

Key Responsibilities

- Research and write news, feature and profile articles for the newsGP platform
- Translate complex information into clear, easy-to-understand language
- End-to-end coordination of writing projects
- Develop effective relationships with key internal and external stakeholders
- Liaise across internal teams to support the delivery of best practice content writing
- Tailor content to ensure it's aligned to the RACGP's values and voice
- Participate in the RACGP performance review cycle
- Comply with all relevant workplace policies and procedures.
- Other duties as required.
