### Training region:

The RACGP recognises and supports the professional development and networking of supervisors as critical to the delivery of quality general practice training.

Supervisor educational events are delivered at a regional and local level both face-to-face and online to ensure all supervisors have access to professional development. These events present an excellent opportunity to connect with your fellow supervisors and medical educators in a friendly and collegiate environment. Increasingly we will be using peer-led small group learning sessions as the basis for supervisor education as this will enable you to learn from your peers and have education that meets your needs.

All the local and regional supervisor education events for existing supervisors listed in this calendar will automatically qualify as contributing to the supervisor professional development stipend paid to the eligible training sites. ## Module 8: Review and Reflection (AGPT)

Module 8 is an optional activity that can be completed by new supervisors following 3-12 **months experience as a GP supervisor**. New supervisors will be automatically enrolled in this module on gplearning once they have attended the Foundations of GP Supervision face-to-face workshop. The following steps are required to complete this module:

1. Read the brief refresher page on the three core skills.
  - Consultation observation and feedback (module 3)
  - Random Case Analysis (module 5)
  - Problem case discussion (module 7)
2. Read the information about recording a video of one of the three core skills.
3. Acknowledge you have received your registrar's verbal consent.
4. Video record yourself demonstrating one of the core skills with your registrar.
5. Select which core skill is demonstrated in your video recording.
6. Answer questions to prompt further reflection and learning on the submitted video.
7. Upload the recording at the 'Video submission' link in this module.
8. Receive feedback on your submitted video by participating in an online small group supervisor education session where you can learn from each other by receiving and giving feedback on each other's video recordings. In some instances, feedback may be 1:1
