Supervisor Professional Development Activities

The NSW and ACT supervisor educational events are being delivered at a regional and local level, both face-to-face and in online formats to best enable all supervisors to attend. Supervisor professional development program events offered within NSW and the ACT in 2025 are detailed below, separated into local training area events and regional events (all of NSW & ACT).

All the local and regional supervisor professional development events for existing supervisors listed in this calendar will meet the RACGP Supervisor Professional Development (SPD) requirements and attract CPD hours when attending the “live” event. See the [CPD for General Practice Supervisors](#) document for more information. The RACGP will provide a supervisor professional development stipend to eligible training sites each semester. Eligible supervisors located in MMM2-7 practices with a current registrar may be eligible for reimbursement of travel expenses to face-to-face events. From early April SPD travel expenses claims may be made via the TMS, refer to the [Flexible Funds policy](#), or contact your Training Coordinator for details.

In 2025 peer-led small group learning sessions will be a significant component of the local training area workshops and we look forward to building ongoing connections and engagement between supervisors within each local training area. GP supervisors will be invited to attend individual local training area workshops, both face-to-face and online, with the face-to-face workshops presenting an excellent opportunity for connection with your fellow supervisors and medical educators in a friendly and collegiate environment. GP supervisors will also be invited to attend regional webinars. These regional events are delivered online, and in some circumstances may have an interactive small group component. Where indicated regional webinars may form part of a pre workshop requirement to connect with subsequent small group learning sessions at face-to-face workshops in the local training area.

Local Training Area Supervisor Events

Local Training Area Workshops

A selection of topics will be offered at workshops in different locations and online during 2025. Please refer to the table below to identify the potential topics that will be offered at each individual event. We aim to provide varied and flexible educational content across the year to meet the professional development needs of supervisors. Supervisors will receive an invitation outlining the planned program for each individual event closer to the date, and this online calendar will be updated accordingly. Until individual event programs are confirmed for each local training area the topic will be listed as 'to be confirmed' (tbc). In 2025 where whole day workshops are offered supervisors can choose to attend either a half or a full day of the program.

Key	Topic	Description
SGL	Peer-led small group learning – facilitated by a medical educator	50% of time at face-to-face workshops will consist of small group learning with supervisors identifying the learning need priorities, and sharing their experience, skills and resources with each other.
AI	Artificial intelligence for supervisors	This SGL topic explores what is known about registrar use of AI tools during GP training and provides an opportunity to discuss RACGP recommendations for use in GP training and share strategies to support safe and effective use.
CIC	Conversations inviting change	Based on the work of Dr John Launer in the UK, conversations inviting change is a technique used to help your registrar to come to their own answers to the big and little questions that arise in primary care.
CONF	Dealing with role conflicts as a GP supervisor	This topic focuses on some of the potential role conflicts we face as supervisors and explores strategies and resources to support supervisors to prevent or mitigate role conflicts that can occur in practice.
REAS	Why do I always have to PROMPT? – developing your registrars clinical reasoning	This SGL topic will follow on from the regional webinar 'Teaching registrars about diagnostic frameworks'. This activity will focus on how supervisors can support registrars to improve their clinical reasoning and diagnostic skills using frameworks such as Murtagh's PROMPT.
REV	Revisiting previous topics	Previously delivered workshop topics may be revisited, guided by local supervisor learning priorities (e.g. Difficult conversations, Evidence-based medicine, Great Expectations, Random Case Analysis).
SAPT	SAPTs for supervisors	This activity will follow on from the regional webinar 'What the SAPT?' and will form part of small group learning time. This SGL activity focuses on supporting your registrar with exam preparation using SAPTs (Self-Assessment Progress Tests).
TEAM	Managing the supervision team	This topic looks at ways different members of the in-practice supervisory team can effectively communicate and work together, using reflection and feedback to enhance the practice learning environment.

WBA	Demystifying workplace-based assessment – a practical approach for supervisors	This topic focusses on the supervisor role in workplace-based assessment (WBA) activities such as Mini-CEX and the Early Assessment for Safety and Learning (EASL). Using videos of role-played registrar consultations supervisors will have the opportunity to practice assessment, discuss feedback and the associated reports required in the Training Management system (TMS).

Module 8: Review and Reflection (AGPT)

Module 8 is an optional activity that can be completed by new supervisors following 3-12 months experience as a GP supervisor. New supervisors will be automatically enrolled in this module on gplearning once they have attended the Foundations of GP Supervision face-to-face workshop. The following steps are required to complete this module:

1. Read the brief refresher page on the three core skills.
 - Consultation observation and feedback (module 3)
 - Random Case Analysis (module 5)
 - Problem case discussion (module 7)
2. Read the information about recording a video of one of the three core skills.
3. Acknowledge you have received your registrar's verbal consent.

4. Video record yourself demonstrating one of the core skills with your registrar.
5. Select which core skill is demonstrated in your video recording.
6. Answer questions to prompt further reflection and learning on the submitted video.
7. Upload the recording at the 'Video submission' link in this module.
8. Receive feedback on your submitted video by participating in an online small group supervisor education session where you can learn from each other by receiving and giving feedback on each other's video recordings
