The RACGP recognises and supports the professional development and networking of supervisors as critical to the delivery of quality general practice training.

Supervisor educational events are delivered at a regional and local level both face-to-face and online to ensure all supervisors have access to professional development. These events present an excellent opportunity to connect with your fellow supervisors and medical educators in a friendly and collegiate environment. Increasingly we will be using peer-led small group learning sessions as the basis for supervisor education as this will enable you to learn from your peers and have education that meets your needs.

All the local and regional supervisor education events for existing supervisors listed in this calendar will automatically qualify as contributing to the supervisor professional development stipend paid to the eligible training sites. Please read the Supervisor Professional Development document for more information.

Attendance at the events will also attract CPD hours in addition to the hours automatically provided to supervisors. See the CPD for General Practice Supervisors document for more information

Recordings of some webinars will be available for review, However, the SPD stipend and CPD hours are only awarded for attendance at the live events and not for watching the recordings.

Eligible supervisors located in MMM3-7 practices with a current registrar may be eligible for reimbursement of travel expenses to face-to-face events. Claims may be made via the TMS, refer to the Flexible Funds policy, or contact your Training Coordinator for details.

Supervisors will receive a registration invitation outlining the planned program for each individual event closer to the date.

Foundations of GP Supervision Program: face-to-face workshop - by invitation only for new supervisors

It is a requirement for all new supervisors working in general practice to complete the initial seven modules of the Foundations of GP Supervision Program, including attendance at a face-to-face workshop or a series of webinars. Supervisors are registered to attend after acceptance of their application to be a supervisor. The planned dates for the Foundations of GP Supervision Program are listed below. Funding is available for travel and accommodation for all new supervisors where their training practice is MMM3-7.

Module 8: Review and Reflection (AGPT)

Module 8 is an optional activity that can be completed by new supervisors following 3-12 **months experience as a GP supervisor.** New supervisors will be automatically enrolled in this module on gplearning once they have attended the Foundations of GP Supervision face-to-face workshop. The following steps are required to complete this module:

1. Read the brief refresher page on the three core skills.

- Consultation observation and feedback (module 3)
- Random Case Analysis (module 5)
- Problem case discussion (module 7)
- 2. Read the information about recording a video of one of the three core skills.
- 3. Acknowledge you have received your registrar's verbal consent.
- 4. Video record yourself demonstrating one of the core skills with your registrar.
- 5. Select which core skill is demonstrated in your video recording.
- 6. Answer questions to prompt further reflection and learning on the submitted video.
- 7. Upload the recording at the 'Video submission' link in this module.
- 8. Receive feedback on your submitted video by participating in an online small group supervisor education session where you can learn from each other by receiving and giving feedback on each other's video recordings. In some instances feedback may be 1:1
