Your Role

The NCL (National Clinical Lead) Education Strategy and Development plays a critical role in providing

national oversight of the development, implementation, and maintenance of the RACGP Education Framework and its guiding instruments. Working closely with the Senior Education Advisor and the Head of Education, Governance and Development, the role provides key inputs and clinical advice to ensure the education framework meets the required standards.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide clinical advice and undertake selected projects encompassing the stages of creation, development, materials production, delivery and/or evaluation.
- Guides and works closely with the Senior Education Advisor in areas relating to accreditation (Australian Medical Council and other types) to developing submissions, updates and/or reports.
- Works with the training program teams and Continuing Professional Development (CPD) in the oversight and development of educational resources for the RACGP.



- Provide medical education advice, policy development, coordination, and review, particularly in relation to the Education Governance and Development team's functional areas of responsibility as they relate to GP (General Practice) training and education at all stages of the GP lifecycle.
- Lead, provide support, advocate, and give guidance including specific advice on matters of expertise across all business units, and mentorship to clinicians within the unit.
- Contribute to formulating long-term strategic plans to improve RACGP educational outcomes and their processes as well as risk mitigation identification and recommendations.
- Provide oversight and participate in the review and updating of the Educational Framework and its guiding instruments.
- Review and develop RACGP reports, responses, papers, guides and/or resources when requested, including
 providing feedback and advice. Provide advice to the business when National Guidelines change and develop
 ad hoc reports as required.
- Participate in the RACGP Performance Review cycle.
- Comply with all relevant workplace policies and procedures.
- Other duties as required.
