

## 2025.1 GPT1 and GPT2 Registrar Out-of-Practice Education Program

**Region:** Victoria

**Subregion:** Rural North East

Registrars must attend the RACGP's out-of-practice education program during their GPT1 & GPT2 terms as a requirement to Fellow. Attendance contributes to their education hours within the registrar's TMS portfolio.

The out-of-practice education program comprises a mix of large group and small group activities facilitated either face to face or via an online platform such as Zoom. The peer-led small group learning (SGL) sessions are specifically focused on registrars working in a stable group with their peers and medical educators. The small group learning sessions are semi-structured and tailored to the learning needs of the group.

The out-of-practice education program is underpinned by the RACGP *Curriculum and syllabus*.
